



TOOL POLICY

When accepting tools for consignment the consignor will insure that item(s) are clean and in good working order. The items that Delaware Tool Exchange will NOT accept include but are not limited to:

- Incomplete sets (i.e., sockets)
- Cordless (battery-powered) tools without a battery and charger
- Electrical tools with defective/frayed/taped cords or other unsafe conditions
- Gasoline-powered equipment that will not start/run
- Dirty tools (i.e., covered in grease/paint/drywall plaster)
- Bent /broken/defective tools
- Rusted tools

The consignor will take back any items that do not conform to the standards listed above. Delaware Tool Exchange will not take responsibility for disposal of the item(s).

Tool boxes will be accepted provided they are clean and in good shape. Any items left in the toolbox upon acceptance, unless otherwise discussed, immediately become the property of Delaware Tool Exchange and may be sold or disposed of at their discretion.

Delaware Tool Exchange reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any tool at their discretion.

Delaware Tool Exchange exists in order to help its customers make money from good tools that they no longer need. We respectfully ask that any potential consignors not look at us as a means to dispose of unwanted items better suited for trash day pickup.
